Analysis of Alumni Feedback On Curriculum Department of Computer Science

Academic Year 2020-2021

The Alumni meet for the year 2020-21 was conducted online on 2nd January 2021. Dr. Ranjit Patil Incharge-Principal of Dr. D. Y. Patil Arts, Commerce and Science College, Pimpri was the chief guest of the program along with him coordinator Mrs. Sujata Patil and some international students were present for the meet.

Around 85 alumni students have been participated to facilitate the program. The meet aimed to reunite the students working in various places and helped to share their work experience. Alumni feedback helps to improve the accountability of the system. The following analysis can be deduced from the alumni feedback,


- Most of the alumni(88.23%) agreed with the adequateness of the courses offered in the programme, 2.35% were uncertain, and 9.42% disagreed.
- 63.53% of alumni felt that the syllabus content helps to bridge the gap between academia and industry, 1.18% were uncertain, and 35.29% disagreed.
- 58.82% of alumni agreed about the curriculum is related to current professional standards, 1.18% were uncertain, and 40% disagreed.
- 64.71% of alumni said that the skills acquired from the curriculum help to face the industry challenges, 2.35% were uncertain, and 32.94% of alumni disagreed.
- 95.29% of alumni were happy with the institute's laboratory and equipment adequateness for practical exposure, 1.18% were uncertain and 2.35% disagreed.
- 96.47% of alumni given positive feedback for the design of the course in terms of extra learning or self-learning, 1.18% were uncertain, and 2.35% disagreed.

The ranking is done as per the following scales from 1 to 5. (1- Strongly agree, 2- Agree, 3- Uncertain, 4- Disagree, 5- Strongly disagree)






Question 2. Rate the sufficiency of the syllabus content to bridge the gap between academia and industry




Question 3. Rate the curriculum in relation to your current professional standards




Question 4. Rate the skills acquired from the curriculum to face the industry challenges required
