## Employer Feedback On Curriculum Department of Computer Science Academic Year 2020-2021

The Placement Cell of the college networks with various industry sectors to organize campus placements and facilitate fresh graduates with employment. In this process, the students get exposure to corporate life from the campus. To understand and meet up to the expectation of the industry demands, the College is collecting the opinion of various stakeholders on the curriculum of the programs offered by it to enrich the quality and enhance employability of its Graduates. The college makes certain that the curriculum offered is in keeping with the demands of the time. A systematic procedure is followed to maintain the standard. The curricula of all programmes are revised once in three years to ensure relevance. This effort is materialized in the form of feedback that is collected from stakeholders about the curriculum.

The feedback for the college is taken by the employer for every academic session. Around 49 employers have given feedback for the academic year 2020-2021. The following analysis can be deduced from the employer feedback,

- 65.31% of employers strongly agreed that curriculum is relevant for employability, 6.12% were uncertain, and 24.49% disagreed.
- 87.76% of employers felt that curriculum is effective in developing innovative thinking, 8.16% were uncertain, and 4.08% disagreed.
- 79.60% of employers strongly agreed that syllabus is effective in developing skill-oriented human resources, 12.24% were uncertain, and 8.16% disagreed.
- 65.31% of employers strongly agreed that the syllabus is need-based, 10.20% were uncertain, and 24.49% disagreed.
- 59.19% of employers strongly agreed that curriculum is effective for the development of entrepreneurship, 8.16% were uncertain, and 32.65% disagreed.




The ranking is done as per the following scales from  $1\ \mathrm{to}\ 5.$ 

(1- Strongly agree, 2- Agree, 3- Uncertain, 4- Disagree, 5- Strongly disagree)









Question 3. Syllabus effective in developing skill oriented human resources.
